## TIME

We just “changed time” again as our state does every 6 months. (Did you know that there are parts of the country that do not participate in this adjustment? Voted against it!) Actually we didn’t “change time” but rather adjusted the clock to a different time. We cannot do anything to “time” except use it or waste it. I had always heard that as you get older time seems to go faster. Well, each hour still has 60 minutes, no more, no less, BUT my perception is that those minutes move MUCH faster now that I am older! Einstein had a theory that time is relative to the speed we travel. I have never been able to comprehend the full meaning of that but do know that people who move faster usually seem to have more time to do more things.

For God, being eternal, time is meaningless. Psalms 90:4(NIV) tells us “For a thousand years in your sight are like a day that has just gone by, or like a watch in the night.” Early mankind (before the flood) experienced long life times of up to 969 years but God obviously did not approve of how they spent it because Genesis 6:5 records that “everything they thought or imagined was consistently and totally evil”. He shortened the lifespan after that and for us time is limited and precious! Even David said in Psalms 39:4(NIV) “Show me, O LORD, my life’s end and the number of my days; let me know how fleeting is my life. Solomon, who had anything money could buy, recognized that you can’t “buy time” Ecclesiastes 3:1(NIV) “There is a time for everything, and a season for every activity under heaven:”

How do use your time? How much do we really value what we have been blessed with? Remember it is a gift, not a guarantee! Paul told us to use it for good in Galatians 6:9(NIV) Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up. The writer of Hebrews warned us in Hebrews 4:7(NIV) Therefore God again set a certain day, calling it Today, when a long time later he spoke through David, as was said before: “Today, if you hear his voice, do not harden your hearts.” Peter challenged us in 1 Peter 5:6(NIV) Humble yourselves, therefore, under God’s mighty hand, that he may lift you up in due time.

How much do you value time? Where are the priorities?

- Do we appreciate some down time to relax and get refreshed and recharged or feel like we must be busy all the time?
- Do we value and consider sacred the time in prayer and meditation and study of God’s word or just fit it in when possible?
- Do we take every advantage to lift others up and point them to God for healing and hope or just when they ask or it is convenient?
- Do we dread what tomorrow holds or look forward to God’s daily promises in whatever form they appear?
